VIP Addresses were undertaken by the Hon. Minister for Education, Heritage and Arts, the Vice Chancellor of Fiji National University, the President of IVETA and the Chairman of IVETA WORLD TVET Conference Organising Committee.

Keynote Addresses were delivered by:

- Prof. Santosh Mehrotra who is a Human Development Economist who talked from the heart and 'did not mince words'. He also had a great sense of humour and made us think about what we are trying to do today in TVET.
- Prof. Pamela Nilan who was an experienced youth worker who has wide international experience. She brought up issues we are all currently experiencing in TVET today and made us think as well as offering possible solutions.
- Ms Wendy Perry who is well known in the area of Workforce, Planning and Development and Entrepreneurship. She focused on where the jobs of the future would come from and emphasised that we must prepare our graduates now and into the future to take on these roles. Higher skills for workers from now and into the future is an essential outcome of training.
- Ambassador Andrew Jacobs who is Head of the European Union Delegation for the Pacific. He focused on the importance of TVET today and where the funding would be directed to achieve outcomes that would support employment requirements for the future.
